Parents/Carers should not arrive before 3.00pm to avoid congestion at our regular school closure time.

The evening between 5.00pm and 8.00pm gives parents and carers the opportunity to visit the school and have a look around. Departments will be showcasing their subjects as well as giving you the chance to find out general information about uniform, day structure, the start of term and all other relevant details that will allow your child a smooth transition in September.

I would be most grateful if you could complete the enclosed admissions form and return it to school either before Wednesday 1st July or on the day/evening itself.
