

Catch-up funding

In 2016-17 Hanson Academy is initially allocated £37 000. This provides an additional £500 for every student joining school who has a Standardised Age Score of below 100 in either Ks2 English or Maths. A score of 100 is the average for that Year group nationally. The funding is provided to help those students 'catch-up' to their peers in their first year in their secondary school.

Appoint a reading coordinator for September 2016 to conduct the accelerated reading scheme as well as teach the catch-up groups. 50% of salary costs.	£12847
Over the Summer break Hanson ran a Summer school programme for 30 low attaining students that were joining the School in September. The programme ran for 6 weeks and involved 7 adults.	£5500
Appoint a HLTA to support Reading in the Learning Resource centre through timetabled reading lessons for Years 7 and 8. 50% of salary costs	£8773
Accelerated Reading Scheme; books, licences, and quizzes	£2700
Rewards and vouchers plus contribution to educational visits for Year 7 children	£1200
Year 7 Bushcraft residential 50% contribution shared with Pupil Premium funding (£6345 from PP)	£6350
